BPS Club Activities

- To book your child onto a club you will need to go to <u>mychildatschool.co.uk</u>, enter your log in details. On the left hand side there is a tab called Clubs and Trips, select this. You will then come to a screen that shows you the available clubs. Select the Club that your child would like to attend and then click enrol. If there are enough spaces, your child will automatically be added to the Club. There are a set number of spaces for each group. If the maximum number has been reached, you can put your child on the waiting list. It will be on a first come, first served basis. All clubs available will go live on MCAS on <u>Tuesday 16th April at 8:30am</u>.
- The after school clubs run until **4.15pm** unless otherwise stated. Please be prompt collecting your child as leaders often have other commitments after the club finishes.
- <u>CLUBS DO NOT RUN THE FIRST AND LAST WEEK OF THE FULL TERM</u> but carry on as normal around half terms. (Summer Term clubs will run 22nd April – 12th July)
- PrimaryForestSchool and STAMP Drama Club will be offering an after school club, this is NOT booked via MCAS and need to be booked directly with the supplier.
- As always, Mrs Galpin's After-School Care is available every evening afterschool; Mon-Thurs 3:10-5:10 & Fri 3:10-4:10. This can be booked and paid for on MCAS.
